All tariffs include free domestic payments – both incoming and outgoing – including instant payments, Payment a Contact, standing orders, and direct debits, payments through MojePlatba service, as well as incoming and outgoing SEPA payments. Cash withdrawals and debit card balance inquiries in the shared ATM network, which includes ATMs operated by KB, MONETA Money Bank, Air Bank, and UniCredit Bank, and cash deposits via deposit ATMs of KB, MONETA Money Bank, and Air Bank are also free of charge.

- ¹⁾ If a mix of CZK/EUR banknotes and coins is deposited and it contains more than more than 50 pcs of CZK coins/10 pcs of EUR coins, the deposit shall be typed in two items (banknotes and coins separately). In the case of an over-the-counter deposit, the customer shall communicate two requirements. In the case of a deposit handed over in a sealed envelope or through a night safe, the customer shall split the deposit of banknotes and coins into two different envelopes and attach a cash deposit slip to each; failing this, the deposit shall be considered as a coin deposit. Any mixed deposit with a lower number of coins shall be typed as a deposit of banknotes that are commonly purchased. Transactions made at the exchange rate are charged as "Cash deposit at the branch up to 50 pcs of CZK coins".
- ²⁾ A third party is a person who is not the account holder or a authorized person to handling the account into which the money is deposited. A third person shall pay the fee in cash, up to the maximum amount of CZK 500 per transaction.
- ³⁾ This amount includes the cumulative deposits into/withdrawals from all your current accounts made by you, your agents or third parties at a branch, in sealed envelopes or through an ATM. We are entitled to charge a fee due on the 5th Business Day of the following month and debit your account by the last day of that month at our discretion.

- ¹⁾ Reasonable costs incurred in connection with the collection of the overdue amount, including the costs associated with sending the reminder. It is collected if the amount due is equal to or greater than CZK 500.

General Provisions

1. The fees for the banking services are collected in CZK and settled in the account currency or in the account main currency (on the case of Multi-Currency Accounts). The fees will be converted using the current KB mean rate. The amount of the fees collected in cash in CZK shall be rounded to the nearest valid denomination of legal tender money in circulation.
2. Unless specified otherwise in a particular case, we shall start charging the fee for the tariff from the next succeeding day after you have chosen it. The tariff fee, or a pro rata portion thereof, shall be payable on the last day of the calendar month for which it is charged, unless otherwise stated. If the tariff is changed during the month, the pro rata portion of the fee for the original tariff shall be payable at the date of such change while the pro rata portion for the new tariff shall be payable on the last day of the calendar month for which it is charged. If, for any reason, the process of cancellation of the last account under the tariff is initiated, the pro rata portion for the calendar month in question shall be payable at the date on which the cancellation of the last account is initiated and the tariff charge shall no longer be charged from that date. Unless we agree otherwise, we may debit the tariff fee from any of your accounts as we choose (we shall generally debit it from your oldest current account held under the tariff). You can find out which account we shall debit the fee from in the KB+ mobile or web app, where you can also change the selection of the account.
3. Where the term 'price', 'charge' or 'reimbursement' is used in the respective contracts for the provision of services entered into by and between us, it means the fee as set out in this Pricelist of Products and Services for Natural Persons (Business) and Legal Persons.
4. Unless we agree otherwise with you, we shall provide you with products and services not listed in this Pricelist of Products and Services for Natural Persons (Business) and Legal Persons for free.
5. The Bank accepts CZK and EUR coins only.

This Pricelist of Products and Services for Natural Person Entrepreneurs and Legal Entities shall take effect as from 1 February 2025 and shall repeal and replace the Pricelist of Products and Services for Natural Person Entrepreneurs and Legal Entities effective from 1 November 2024.
