- ✓ Consulting services are complemented with a financing offer – loan, green loan, investment loan for sustainable projects.
- ✓ Subsidized projects include investments into improving the energy efficiency of existing buildings, such as thermal insulation, high efficiency heating, ventilation and air-conditioning systems, high efficiency lighting, renewable energy sources linked to buildings (photovoltaic, biomass, and solar collector systems), and investments aimed at reducing the energy intensity of production and technological processes.

How does ELENA work?

- ✓ The programme is intended for medium and large enterprises with up to 3,000 employees and for the public sector.
- √ To obtain the discount, the investment project must be executed no later than in March 2027.
- √ The minimum amount of investment costs is CZK 10 million.
